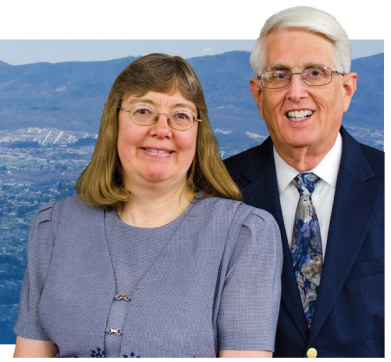


Steven & Debra ANNER HONDURAS

His Leading in Our Move

Since we arrived we have been busy getting adjusted to our new location. We found a house to rent on the south side of Tegucigalpa, but the owner is adding kitchen cabinets and making minor repairs before we move in. Our move in date is July 1. However, we can start to move in our things that we are having shipped from the states as well as furniture and appliances. Until we can move in, we will continue to stay in the hotel in Santa Lucía. We have also been shopping for furniture. Please pray with us that God would give us wisdom in purchasing these items. Please pray also about our need for a car. At this point we have seen several, but all are several thousand dollars beyond what we have budgeted for a vehicle.

His Leading in Our Ministry

We have been busy in serving the Lord in various ministries. We mentioned before that Evan Williams, the missionary with whom we are working, has asked us to take over two of the mission points. We feel certain that God is leading us to one, that is Centroamérica Oeste on the western side of Tegucigalpa. Steven will teach the adults while Debra will be working with a children’s Bible club. Please pray with us concerning the other mission point. We are leaning toward one in 30 de Noviembre (some parts of the city have dates for their names). There is no children’s club there, but the doors are open to use part of a school for the Bible club.

Steven has also been helping with the preaching, both at the main church and at Iglesia Bautista Betania. Bethany Baptist Church was started by BIMI missionary Carlos Johnson, who passed away in April of this year. Please pray for this church and their need for a pastor.

His Leading in Our Residency

We were able to meet with a lawyer recently to discuss the process of getting our residency. The lawyer gave us a list of nineteen documents that we have to get to start the process. Four of those documents have to come from the states. These documents must be apostilled in order to be accepted. We thought that we might have to make a short trip to the states to get those documents. However, with the help of our director and the staff at BIMI it looks like we can get them without making the trip. Please pray that process goes smoothly.
