He was able to see his family doctor and a specialist who inserted the tube in his ear that he has been needing. That has helped tremendously. His health concerning the other areas has been

improving as well. Please continue to pray with us for complete healing.

Sun and Shield

When we think about the purpose of the sun, we realize that it dispels the darkness and helps us to see clearly. As we have examined what the Lord has done with Jonathan, we realize now why coming to Honduras was a necessary part of his recovery process. Not only has he been able to better balance the left side of his body with the help of trainers at the gym, his speech and short term memory have improved.

The fact that the Lord is our shield reminds us of His protection. In our last letter we told you about the

Streets that we usually take to different ministries are often blocked. We have had to cancel events because of the blockades and the violence. We praise the Lord for protecting us.
