We still have to renew that permission every year, but the renewal process is fairly easy.

We are grateful for how the Lord worked in the lives of our people while we were gone. Two families from our church live in Centroamérica Oeste, Jairo and Karla, and Lenin and Lizbet. We hold the weekly club in the house of Jairo and Karla. The adult

Bible study is held in the house of Lenin and Lizbet. Karla came up with the idea to have a “Welcome Back to the Club Party” to get the children involved in the club again. Jairo and Karla had invitations made up and went out to visit their neighbors and invite the children. Karla and Lizbeth prepared pizza and cupcakes. Joel and Monchita, who are our assistants, also helped. We had a great turnout! Twenty children came for the club. The next week we had almost as many children. Please



pray with us that these children will continue to come and soon understand their need to trust Christ as their personal Savior.

Preparations are being made for the start of the Bible Institute. So far, we have about ten people who are interested in studying with us.
