READING THROUGH THE BIBLE

1 Kings 1: 1-4:34 When given a chance to have anything in the world, Solomon asked for wisdom-"an understanding heart"-in order to lead well and to make right decisions (1 Kings 3:6-9). This, in itself, showed wisdom, and God honored Solomon's request. Solomon became the wisest man ever and, at the moving of God's Spirit, recorded much of his God-given insight in the book of Proverbs. God wants to work *through* us, *not/or* us. Notice that Solomon asked for understanding to carry out his job; he did not ask God to do the job for him. Ask God to give you the wisdom to know what to do and the courage to follow through on it. And remember, if you ask for wisdom, God has promised to give you all you need (see James 1 :5).
